




The ministry is going well and we thank God, seeing people committing their lives to Christ and taking serious their relationship with God. It is also encouraging to see people growing in their walk with Christ.

We also thank God for the Grow Track Team, in their commitment to the calling in this ministry.


For 2024, we only have Grow Track class every two months and so far we have done four classes. We are starting another class for September and one more class before the end of the year.



The media team has been particularly busy the last quarter, mostly due to Holiday Bible Club and other events. Thankfully, with Nyikiwe on board full time doing plenty content generation for all ministries, things have remained smooth sailing.

Our YouTube channel is doing well and is the central place where all Sunday sermons get posted. Over the last quarter, we also made all Prayer and Fasting evening sessions available online as well. In the past 90 days, we have gained over 280 views, generated more than 11.5 hours of watch time, and have received nine new subscribers to the channel

Our Facebook remains one of our most pivotal advertising and outreach platforms. In the last 90 days, we have had a reach of over 3,900 people with over 260 content interactions. We have also passed the 410 follower mark.

instagram (rbapchurch.za)

Like Facebook, our Instagram is doing well, with slightly less uptake as the majority of targeted audience for our main church account use Facebook instead. In the last 90 days on Instagram, we've achieved a reach of 1,600, 464 content interactions, and have grown our followers to 182.

Our website remains our second most important online space, beaten only by our socials. In the last 90 days, we have had over 285 site sessions with most connecting directly to the site, followed by those finding us on Google, Instagram, Facebook, and Bing respectively. We are also currently in the process of a Beta update to make the site more user-friendly on mobile and to look more modern.

Our Amplified Youth Facebook account has done moderately well considering most youth prefer Instagram. In the last 90 days, we've had reach of 403, 51 interactions, and grown to 197 followers.

On Instagram, our youth account has done very well. In the last 90 days, we've had reach of over 4,000, more than 885 content interactions, and grown to 293 followers. During Holiday Bible Club we also had more than seven reels reach over 500 views, with two reaching 987 and 948 each.

Among all the poster printing, sermon artwork designs, and everything else, we are also trying to assist with design implementations in the church.



maintenance

Over the last quarter we have completed multiple maintenance projects, including some that have been due for almost over two years. Below are some of the projects done as well as their final cost:



- -- Front Signage: fill and scratch plaster existing air bricks outside front door, seal, paint, and mount laser cut Perspex of church name and logo (+-R4,000)
- -- Side Signage: scratch plaster 3M x 2M section of wall, seal, paint, and mount laser cut Perspex of church name, logo, and URL (+-R5,500)
- -- Windows: Scrap, re-putty, real, and repaint all windows on front and side of church (+-R6,500)
- -- Paint: Prime and paint entire church using durable roofing paint (three coats) (+-R8,000)
- -- Leaf Wall: Install new leaf wall feature at back of church including black trim edging and invite card hooks (+-R2,000)



-- Cry Room: New speakers fully trunked and mounted on floating shelves for parents to enjoy worship and the message on Sundays (R5,000)

God is continuing to open doors in this area for us to see the lost found.




The past three months have been a whirlwind of activity. Some of the most notable events that have occurred have been:

- -- Recruitment in April: We hosted recruitment in April and welcomed a lot of new members to our ministry teams. This has helped our teams function more efficiently and taken some of the stress off of existing team members.
- -- Holy Week and Easter: We had an incredible easter season that premiered with an inhouse movie series following the events of Jesus' last week. The series set the tone for the season of 'Events that Changed the World,' which included a last supper at church.
- -- RPS Leadership Workshop: In July our staff ran a leadership workshop for RPS that helped guide and train their new RCLs. This is the fourth time that RBC has worked with RPS and will continue to do so.
- -- Team's Night: We had a fantastic evening celebrating all the teams that serve in the church. With friendly competition, pizzas on call, and wonderful fellowship, it was a great night spent together.
- -- Prayer and Fasting: Near the end of July we had our annual mid-year week of prayer and fasting. Looking at Heaven on Earth, we had amazing sessions each evening learning about how to access Heaven on Earth and spending time in God's presence. (all sessions are loaded on rbapchurch.org for anyone who missed out).
- -- Holiday Bible Club: One of the biggest events of the year is our annual Holiday Bible Club. This year we only ran the program in one location: the church. Despite this, we welcomed over 100 children and had an amazing week of playing games, fellowship, and most importantly, sharing the Word of God with them. We ended the week with a concert that required the overflow of our church due to the turnout.
- -- Life.Groups: Life.Groups have continued and have been a great way to stay (or get) connected outside of regular church meetings. We consistently have no less than three venues each time and encourage all to join us at the next one.
- -- Mother's/Father's Day: We had special days to celebrate the mom's and dad's, with eats galore and special gifts for all our parents.
- -- Salvation Month: August was our annual Salvation Month where we encourage everyone to invite someone to church to hear incredible testimonies. The month went well and we heard undeniable stories of God's love in unique testimonies from church partners.
- -- ARC Conference: At the start of September a group from various teams attended the ARC Conference.



As the year winds down and everyone prepares for the end of the year, we have exciting things to look forward to

- -- Family Day (14 September): We will be having Family Day for the first time since 2019! We will be spending the day in Magaliesburg, starting with a climb up Faith Mountain followed by games and meals at Hornbill Lodge.
- -- Youth Rally (13 September): Amplified Youth will be attending a Youth Rally on the 13th. The team have been actively engaged in assisting to organize the rally and it is the 4th time the interdenominational rally will be held.
- -- Men's meeting: We want to invite the men to have an outing or gather such as a braai. This can be decided by the men and we invite volunteers to come forward for this.
- -- RCL Selection Camp: Our staff will be organizing and running the RPS RCL selection camp in October. This will take place over three days and requires 20 leaders.
- -- Summer Camp: Amplified Youth will be traveling to Barkley West in December to join the annual BYSA summer camp. This has been advertised and all youth are encouraged to save up for the event.
- -- Life.groups: Life.groups will be continuing until the end of the year. Keep an eye out for when these are taking place and make sure to join us as we do life together.
- -- Carols: We will be having our annual carols service in early December to officially usher in the Christmas Season.
- -- Teams Year End: After Carols we will be holding a final team's night in appreciation of all who served this year.

call committee feedback

Continuous progress has been made by the Call Committee, who has been meeting regularly. As of this Q.P.M, the first drafts for the pastor profile, application questionnaire, and employment contract have been written. These will be finalized by the end of the month, after which the position of pastor will be advertised in various places alongside the Baptist Union of SA.


After the position has been advertised, the following will take place:*

- -- Potential applications are screened by the Call Committee
- -- Favourable applicants will be identified and engaged with
- -- Virtual or digital meetings and interviews will take place with potential pastors
- -- A short list of applicants will be made
- -- Secondary interviews will be held
- -- Pastors will be invited to preach at RBC

*These are the general guidelines for calling a new pastor and may not occur exactly as stipulated.

- -- A final selection will be made
- -- The call committee will present the selection to the church for final vote
- -- The new pastor will be called







Each year, we set a budget for the church. This guides our spending so that we don't go crazy!

upcoming expenses

- -- Bathroom renovations: Full strip and demolish of both bathrooms followed by full retile and fitting of new toilets/urinals and basins +-R50,000.
- -- Kitchen renovations: Sand down of all cabinets and paint with durable enamel and final sealant. Replace all handles and fit granite counter by sink. +-R10,000
- -- Front of church overhaul: Remove circle and designate new parking, build planters, and install security fencing. R+-25,000
